To The Washington Public Disclosure Commission,

Communico (Greg Hanon) lobby's for Monsanto. Monsanto recently merged with Bayer and in June we filed a new L-1 to reflect the merger and began filing our monthly reports to include Bayer and not Monsanto. However, when making the revision we did not also change the client reference in the lobbying activity portion of the L-2 on our reports from June 2019 – September 2019. We have amended the lobbying reporting activity on our L-2's to accurately reflect Bayer and not Monsanto. In the amended filing, the on-line reporting functionality will not allow removal of Monsanto under the lobbying reporting activity as the document is already a public/published document. We are sending this memo as clarification that all lobbying reporting activity for Monsanto should have been changed over to Bayer beginning June 2019 to reflect the merger. We have terminated all remaining months on the Monsanto L-1 to accurately reflect these changes.
