Every couple years, as your lobbyist, we are required to re-file our lobbyist registration with Washington State's Public Disclosure Commission (PDC). To that end, we've prepared part of the necessary paperwork (the Form L1) and attached it for your review and signature. The second part of that paperwork is an addendum that we will need from you which is outlined in question 8 on the form.

This means we'll need 2 things from you:
